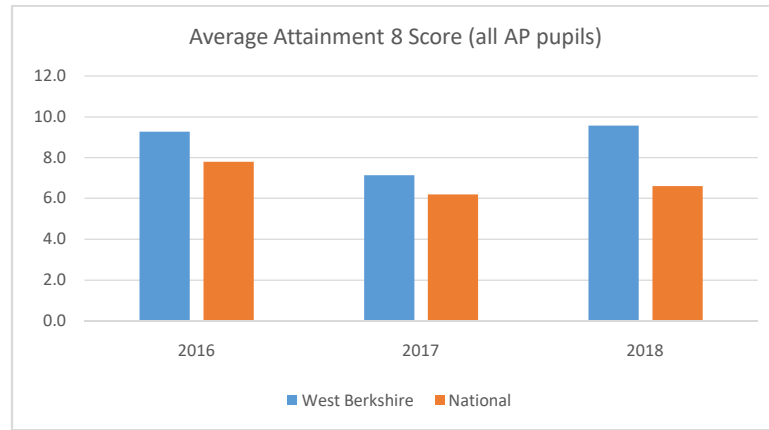

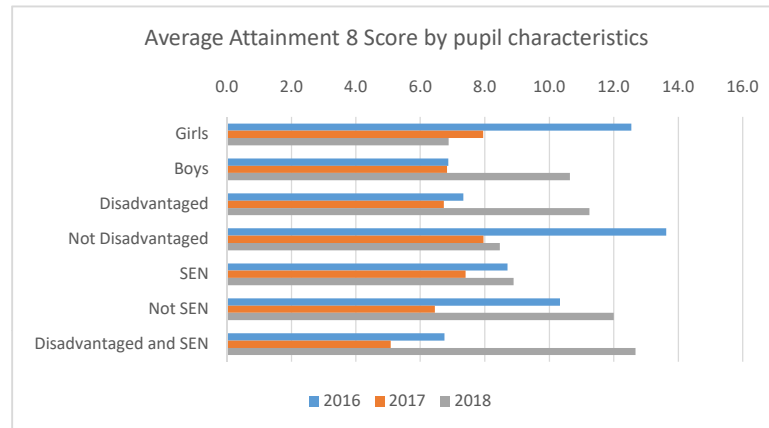

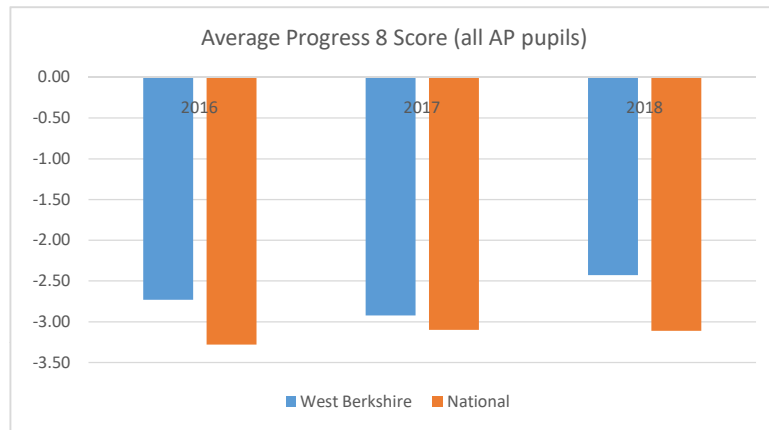


• In general, girls, non-disadvantaged pupils and pupils without SEN all outperform the rest of the cohort, as is seen in mainstream schools

• In 2018, boys outperformed girls and disadvantaged pupils outperformed non-disadvantaged. The 2018 scores were somewhat skewed by the fact that 10 pupils had zero scores (4 girls, 6 boys). In 2017 there were four zero scores (1 girl) and in 2016 there were five (all boys). However, even ignoring the zero scores, boys still outperformed girls by a small margin in 2018.

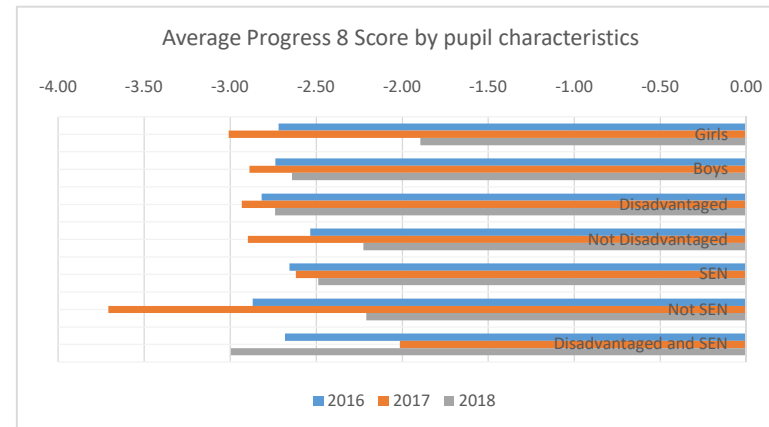

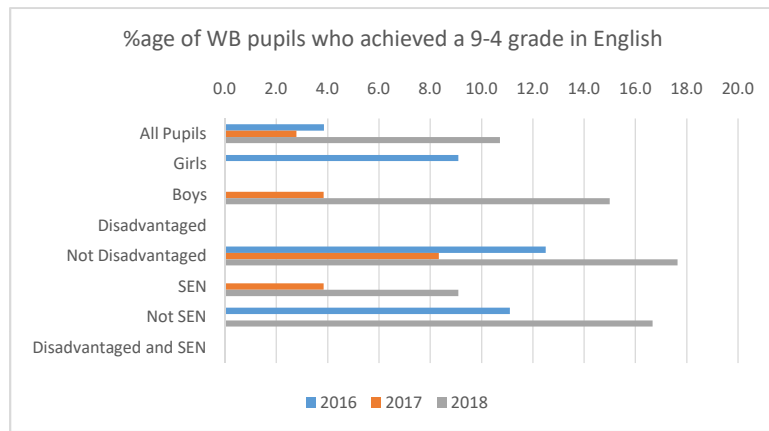

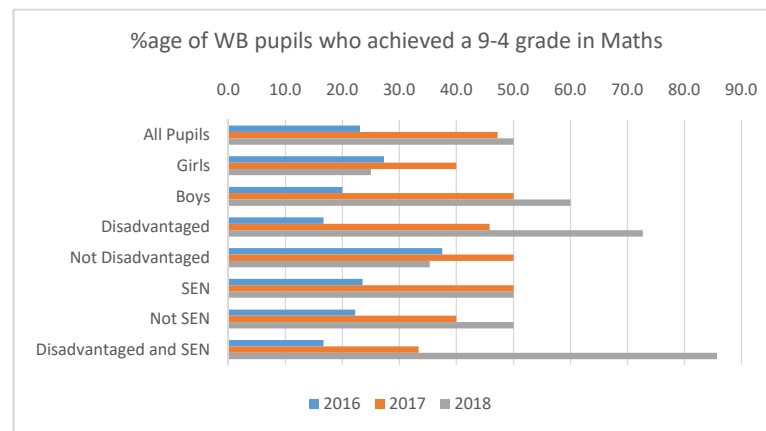

• Attainment in English is low although the 2018 figures show an improvement. No girls achieved a 9-4 grade in 2017 or 2018. No disadvantaged pupils have achieved a 9-4 grade in the past three years.



• Attainment in Maths is higher than in English. In 2018, all groups showed an improvement with the exception of girls and non-disadvantaged pupils.

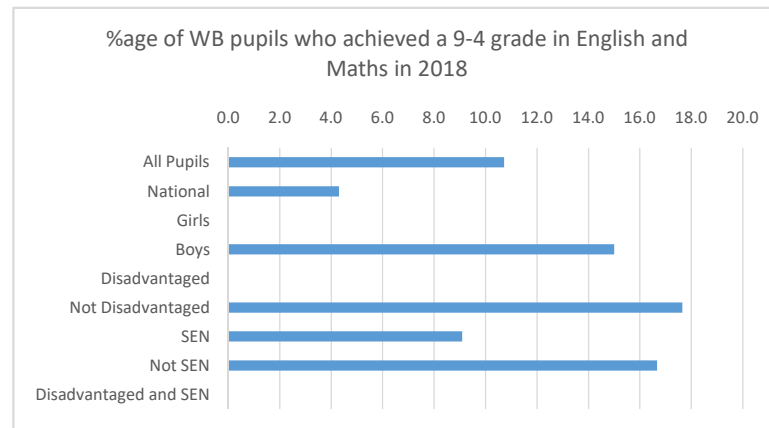
• Disadvantaged and SEN pupils have shown a significant improvement in the past two years. 73% of disadvantaged pupils (8 of 11) achieved a 9-4 grade in 2018. 86% of SEN/disadvantaged pupils achieved a 9-4 grade in 2018.

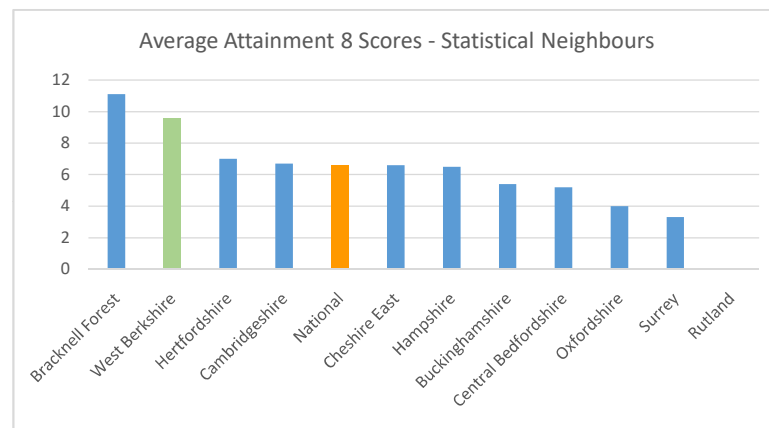

%age of WB pupils who achieved a 9-4 grade in English and Maths in 2018

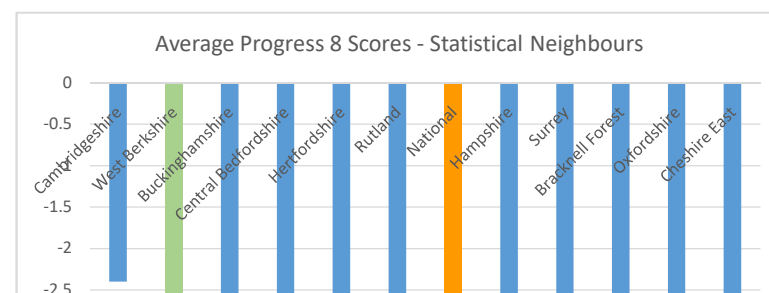

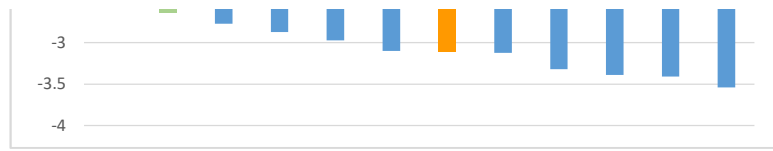
• West Berkshire was in the top quartile of local authorities for both Attainment 8 and Progress 8 in 2018 (ranked 21st of 152 for A8 and 12th for P8). This is an improvement on previous years when West Berkshire was in the second quartile. Note that the improvement was due to an increase of just 2.5 points in absolute terms (7.1 to 9.6). Attainment is low across the whole AP sector.
