#### Analysis 15/16

In 14/15, 63% of students achieved between 1 and 3 GCSE grade C. In 15/16, this has risen to 80% with 7/10 students achieving at least 1 grade C.

100% gained at least 1 GCSE grade A\* – G, including 40% with 4, and 60% left with 6+ nationally recognized qualifications.

No student left with less than 2 nationally recognized qualifications; 90% with 4 or more including English and maths.

2 members of staff took exams; one achieving GCSE grade C and FS Level 2 (A\* - C) in maths, and the other grades B and C in Art and Photography.

#### Analysis 16/17

Outstanding retention rate, indicating that the admission criteria is sound. 2 students completed the year and finished with no higher qualifications than Year 11 due to external influences. One EHCP student achieved the highest English grade across the service. 2 students in year 13 passed 2 x GCSE as re-sits. 46% of students achieved 4 or more GCSE / FS qualifications.

#### Analysis 17/18

\*30% no GCSE / 20% 0 qualifications = exam refusers; 1 x application for EHCP (post 16 in mainstream??), 2 x EHCP returning to Independence 18.19

#### Analysis 18/19

Retention rate is excellent – for the correctly placed learners. 3 x ex Home Ed learners didn't successfully 'transit' despite collaborative work with families, Home Education and iCollege. 2 x SEN learners will return to iCollege for Year 13. All post 16 learners leave with a national qualification in English and maths at grade 4 or above in GCSE or Functional Skills achieved during 17/18 or 18/19 – this meets the DfE target.

#### Analysis 19/20

1 x ex-iCollege / Downs learner achieved A level English Lit grade C, 2 merits and 1 distinction\* BTECH and is now attending Winchester Uni! 1 x iCollege / Little Heath learner achieved A level Philosophy A\*!

4 x learners = EHCP, 1 x LAC, 1 x CIN, 4 x counselling support.

Learners achieving 3 or more GCSE grade 4 and above has increased from 28% in 18/19 to 36% in 19/20, and those achieving 5 or more national qualifications has doubled from 28% to 54%
