KS1/KS2 Careers Commitment

By the end of Key Stage 2, all students will have:



- A better understanding that core subjects support entry to a broad range of careers.
- A better understanding of the importance of succeeding in maths and English.
- A better understanding of post Year 6 transition
- A better understanding of roles in the world of work
- A better understanding of their strengths and areas for development, and the ways skills, attributes and qualities might inform future choices in learning and work.
- Experienced a meaningful encounter annually with local employers to gain a better understanding of work, employment and skills which are valued in the workplace.
- Used careers resources to access information about careersopportunities
- Been offered a group session with independent Careers Advisor

To achieve these outcomes all students will progress through a differentiated and accredited programme of teacher-led topics over a rolling two- year programme, which will include the following activities:

KS1 and **KS2**: Group sessions and presentations which help students to start thinking about their future including what subjects and qualifications are needed for which careers.

Primary students are also introduced to careers through Careers Planet resources, group Adviza sessions, trips and presenters from the world of work.
